About CHAS

The Community Health Assist Scheme (CHAS) enables Singapore Citizens to receive healthcare subsidies for medical and dental care at participating General Practitioner (GP) and dental clinics near their home.



CHAS. Merdeka Generation and Pioneer Generation cardholders can enjoy subsidies at CHAS clinics by showing their CHAS card, Merdeka Generation card or Pioneer Generation card with their NRIC during visit.



Cardholders below 15 years old will need to present their CHAS card and birth certificate/student ID.
